

SKATERS CODE OF CONDUCT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

SKATERS AND SPECTATORS UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Maintain reasonable control of his or her speed and course at all times.
- Read and abide by all posted signs, warnings and cooperate with rink staff.
- Maintain a proper lookout to avoid other skaters, objects or conditions on the surface of the rink.
- Accept responsibility for knowing the range of his or her ability while on skates and skate within those limits.
- Refrain from skating while under the influence of drugs, alcohol or other controlled substance.
- Leave the ice surface during ice resurfacing maintenance
- Refrain from taking food or drink onto the rink surface or the surrounding dasher boards or cap-rail.
- Refrain from acting in a manner that may cause or contribute to the injury of themselves or any other persons.
- Refrain from throwing or leaving objects on the rink surface.
- Refrain from instigating or becoming involved in any type of altercations with any other skater or spectator and shall not engage in abusive, abrasive or disorderly conduct.
- Assumption of Risk: By engaging in skating, skaters and spectators are deemed to have knowledge of, and assume the inherent risks of skating which include but are not limited to the following:
 - Injuries that result from collisions or contact with other skaters or other individuals who are on the skating surface which may lead to injuries, concussions or death
 - Injuries that result from falls.
 - Injuries that involve objects or artificial structures that is within intended path of travel of the skater.
